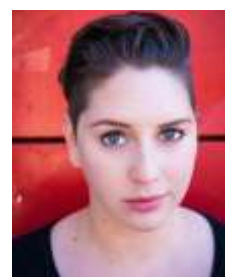
NARRATOR, HEARTSMITH, STUDENT, CAROLER – Zachary Dean
